**MUSIC-143 Notation 1  
Departmental/Challenge Exam**

**To take a departmental challenge exam:**

1. Contact [cple@matc.edu](mailto:cple@matc.edu) to request a challenge exam. CPLE will add the fees to your account when you are ready to pay
2. Pay the nonrefundable fee either on Selfservice or any campus' cashiers office. This must be paid prior to taking the exam. If use of MATC equipment and supplies are necessary to administer challenge exams, additional fees may apply.
3. Contact the test administrator to schedule an exam. A "paid" CPLE form must be turned in to the test administrator.
4. The test administrator will update [cple@matc.edu](mailto:cple@matc.edu) with your results. An MATC Department Exam may not be taken more than once.
