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MUSIC-177, Piano Lab 1, 1 credit Departmental/Challenge Exam

Credit for Prior Learning provides students a range of options to earn college credit for what they already know. Students can demonstrate college-level knowledge and competencies from examination, portfolio, to workforce and military.

To take a departmental challenge exam:

1. Contact cple@matc.edu to request a challenge exam. Provide the course information (title & number). CPLE will add the fees to your account when you are ready to pay
2. Pay the nonrefundable fee either on Selfservice or any campus' cashiers office. This must be paid prior to taking the exam. If use of MATC equipment and supplies are necessary to administer challenge exams, additional fees may apply.
3. Contact the test administrator to schedule an exam. A "paid" CPLE form must be turned in to the test administrator.
4. The test administrator will update cple@matc.edu with your results. An MATC Department Exam may not be taken more than once.

- The test expectancy/summary:**
 - Students must demonstrate through piano performance, skills, technique, vocabulary understanding and reading ability equivalent to or exceeding competency goals and outcomes for MUSIC 177 Piano Lab 1. Student can present three music selections of their choice, approved by the test administrator, or administrator will provide three selections. There will also be a written test including vocabulary, reading and rhythm.
