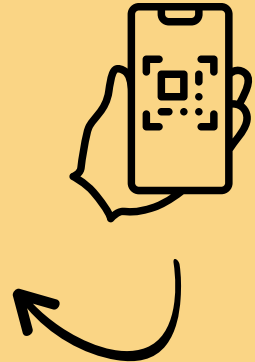

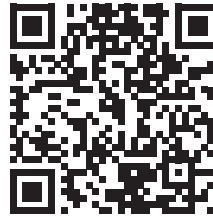

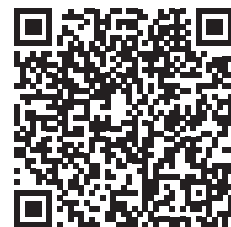




## FOOD & NUTRITION SERVICES

Students in the Community Health and Nutrition Navigator program are available to assist fellow students with identifying healthy food access in communities.



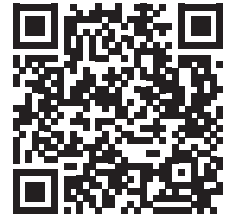


## FOOD & NUTRITION SERVICES

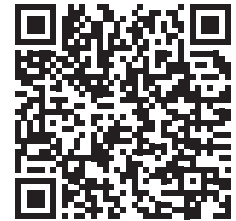
